
## Version 3.0

## Improved Status Information Access

The 3.0 version of the *WebEOC EMResource Interface* makes better use of the information EMResource offers. Using field mapping, WebEOC administrators can now configure any WebEOC board to display standard status type information from EMResource.

Further, all relevant information is seamlessly pushed from EMResource to WebEOC so that emergency planners and responders can use WebEOC to access the very latest information and be prepared for any unplanned incident or emergency response activation.
