## Added ICD-10 Codes to the Primary Impression on Patient Notifications

ICD-10 codes and labels are now included with the Primary Impression component, allowing emergency medical services (EMS) units to better capture the patient's condition. When added to and completed on Add Patient forms, this information automatically appears on patient notifications and transport listings. Extending the value of prehospital and incoming patient notifications, Primary Impression offers critical insight for receiving personnel.

## Introduced File Attachments for Patients Added Through Web Forms

Including the Add File component on Add Patient forms for the Web enables file attachments through tablet and desktop devices. Various types of files, including .png, .jpg, .xlsx, .docx, .csv, and .pdf, can be uploaded and attached.

Attached files appear on the patient record. Access to patient records is restricted according to established security standards; as a result, only people using a password to access EMTrack through the Web can see and open attached files.
